ITEM	MAIN POINTS
Welcome	Mrs Adamson welcomed everyone. E took the minutes and each House took their own notes.
Discussion	<p>House Ambassadors voted to create Christmas decorations for a House Christmas tree.</p> <p>Ideas were discussed for the decorations.</p> <p>Suggestions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Each house has its own tree ● Each child decorates its own plastic bauble ● Each child decorates fir cones <p>Discussion around sustainability and cost was had.</p> <p>It was decided that research by a few ambassadors on costing should occur so that it was affordable.</p> <p>T, J and E stayed with Mrs Adamson to research the costs.</p> <p>T, J and E realised that buying a real Christmas tree for each House, plastic baubles and sourcing enough fir cones would cost over £1000.</p> <p>J suggested a reusable tree which could be kept for next year and that each House could decorate it, take a photo and then the next one could use it.</p> <p>T, J and E did a stock take of left over resources from last year and decided that this could be used again as it had all the right coloured card for the Houses, apart from Purple.</p>
